# camp Odakota

Odakota is Sioux for "friend" and Camp OdakOTa is the place to make new friends. Our camp is designed to provide the support needed to help children with sensory processing disorders develop meaningful relationships. Some children avoid sensory input while others crave it. Because the camp was conceived and developed by occupational therapists, the staff of Camp OdakOTa understands this and will be sensitive to your child's particular sensory needs.

## Why do summer camp with COTI?

COTI is Cincinnati's expert in the area of sensory integration. The camp curriculum has been designed by COTI staff and will anticipate and meet the sensory and environmental needs of our campers to promote their successful participation in summer camp. Children will become a part of a small group of six children with two counselors. They will participate in occupational therapist-led activities throughout each day.

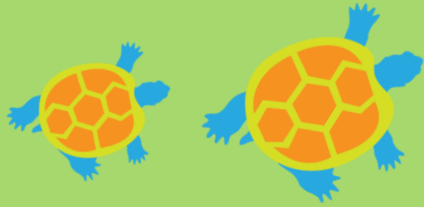

Children with sensory processing challenges have difficulty taking in, interpreting, and responding to sensory input through sight, sound, touch, taste, smell, and movement. These difficulties can affect their ability to form relationships with both peers and adults and can inhibit their ability to participate in many aspects of play. Camp OdakOTa will provide children the opportunity to experience camp life through the support of trained occupational therapy professionals and other staff alongside other children that are experiencing similar challenges. Camp will not be a day of therapy, but rather, a traditional camp experience redesigned with this group of children in mind. We strive to create an environment that will support children with challenges related to sensory processing.



## Who is an OdakOTa Kid?

Camp OdakOTa is for children who are 6-11 years old and who have sensory processing disorder or have symptoms of sensory processing disorder due to other conditions. We are unable to provide support for children who require one-on-one supervision. Please call if you have questions about enrollment criteria.

Free screenings will be completed for all campers during the spring to ensure that Camp OdakOTa is right for them. If the therapist performing the screening does not recommend camp for your child, your deposit will be returned.

# Registration

To secure a spot for your child, please send a deposit of \$200 by check or credit card payable to COTI. Priority will be given to campers who register for all 8-week sessions. Deposits are non-refundable except in the case where there is no space available or, if after a screening at COTI, it is determined that the camp is not a good match for your child.
