

Sensational OT Tip of the Month Assignments

Do you know children that ...?

- 1. Struggle to copy assignments into their planners.
- 2. Their writing when copying from the board is illegible.
- 3. Have difficulty sizing their writing for the space allowed.

They might have visual-motor difficulties making it difficult to scan text and copy text. Assignments get missed or are incomplete.

Sensational Ideas about Assignments

- 1. Draw lines in the planner to help children align and size their writing.
- 2. Give a child a post it note with the assignment on it to copy into the planner (easier to copy paper to paper than from the board).
- 3. Allow older children that have IPads, Laptops, or cell phones to take a picture of the assignment on the board and then transcribe it into the planner.
