Entering 1st-5th grades

This group is designed to provide handwriting enrichment and support for children struggling with the mechanics of writing such as correct letter formation, reversals, sizing, and placement on a writing line. Children will experiment with a variety of strategies to assist with handwriting including pencil grips, slant boards, and handwriting paper. Ideas for home will be provided at each session.

Utilizing a multisensory approach, this group will address the foundational skills needed in prewriting. The focus will be on developing skills such as prewriting strokes and shapes with an introduction to capital letters and numbers in order to prepare children for

Kindergarten handwriting. Through the use of both fine motor and gross motor activities, the group will also address grasp development, eye hand coordination, left/right discrimination, hand dominance, and posture. These are building blocks for writing. Follow up home activities will be given weekly.
