Ages 4 - entering K

Utilizing a multisensory approach, this group will address the foundational skills needed in prewriting. The focus will be on developing skills such as prewriting strokes and shapes, with an introduction to capital letters and numbers in order to prepare children for Kindergarten handwriting.


